Discuss Lego Art:

(use these definitions and questions to guide your discussion)

Perspective: the technique or process of representing on a plane or curved surface the spatial relation of objects as they might appear to the eye; specifically the representation in a drawing or painting of parallel lines as converging in order to give the illusion of depth and distance

Texture: the way that something feels when you touch it

Structure: the way that something is built, arranged, or organized

something (such as a house, tower, bridge, etc.) that is built by putting parts together and that usually stands on its own

Design: to plan and make decisions about (something that is being built or created) : to create the plans, drawings, etc., that show how (something) will be made
